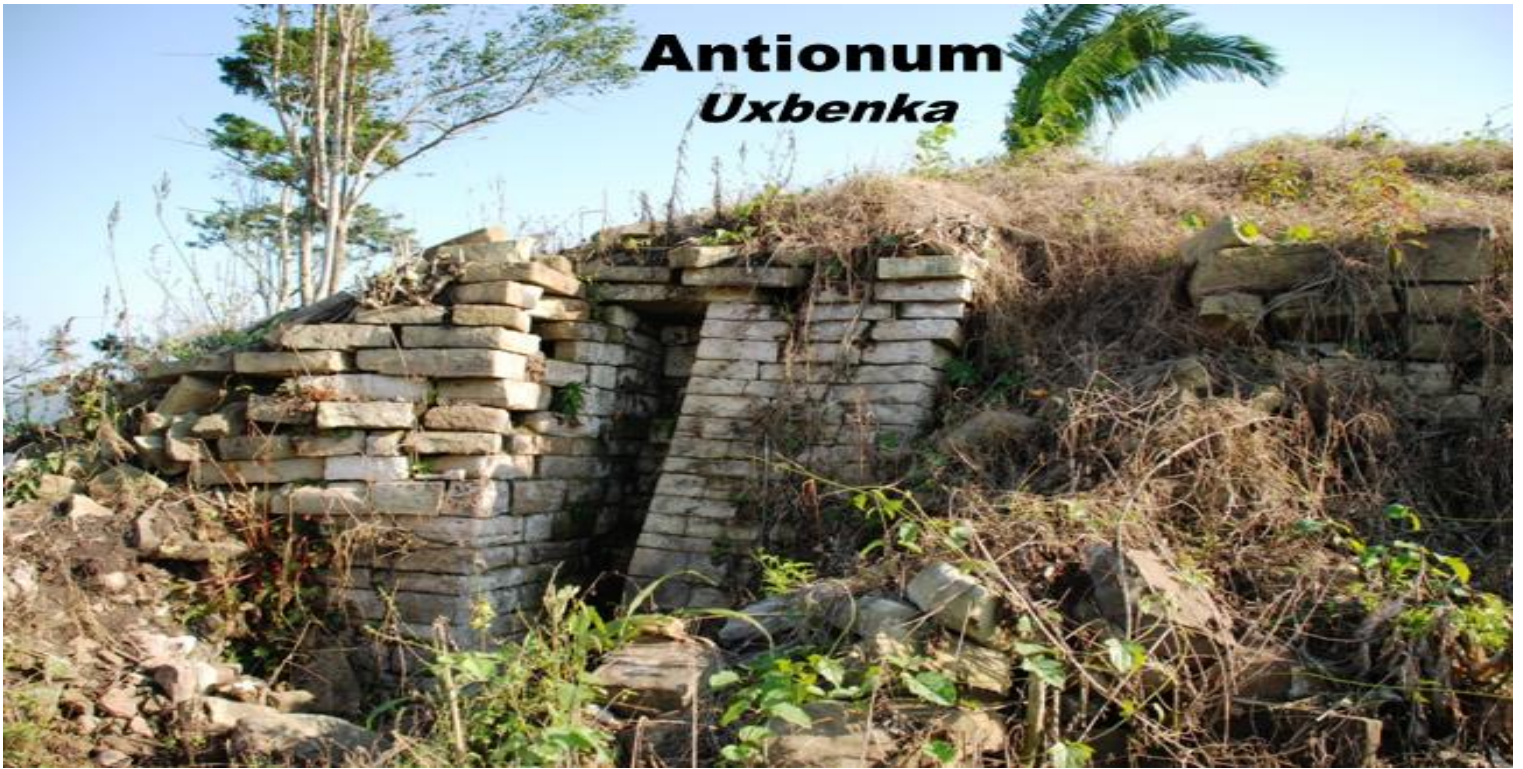


Antionum Uxbenka



Alma 31:3...Antionum...was [a] east of the land of Zarahemla, which lay nearly [b] bordering upon the seashore, which was [c] south of the land of Jershon, which also[d] bordered upon the wilderness south, which wilderness was full of the Lamanites.

Alma 43:22...they durst not come against the Nephites in the borders of Jershon; therefore they departed out of the land of Antionum into the wilderness, and took their journey round about in the wilderness, away by the [e] head of the river Sidon, that they might [j] come into the [f][g] land of Manti...

Alma 43:34...the Lamanites came [h] up on the north of the hill Riplah, where a part of the army of Moroni was concealed.

Alma 39:3 And this is not all, my son. Thou didst do that which was grievous unto me; for thou didst forsake the ministry, and did [i] go over into the land of Siron among the borders of the Lamanites, after the harlot Isabel.

Correlations of ancient sites that are associated with Antionum-Uxbenka:

- a. Zarahemla–Ceibal is west of Antionum-Uxbenka
- b. Antionum-Uxbenka is nearly bordering the seashore-Caribbean.
- c. Antionum-Uxbenka is south of Jershon-Mopan River valley.
- d. Antionum-Uxbenka is bordering the wilderness south-Santa Clara Mountains.
- e. The head of the river Sidon-Pasion is by the south wilderness-Santa Clara- Mountains
- f. The land of Manti-Cancuen is down river from the head of the Sidon River-Pasion.
- g. These claims imply that Manti is west of Antionum.
- h. These correlations solidify the locations of hill Riplah and the locations associated with the river Sidon-Pasion.
- i. Corianton episodes with Isabel had to be in Lamanite territory and fairly close. This correlates well with the proposed locations of Antionum-Uxbenka and Siron-lake Isabel.
- j. These claims imply that the river Sidon-Pasion river runs north.
- k. Uxbenka has the right timeline
- l. Originators of Uxbenka came from the Petén.
