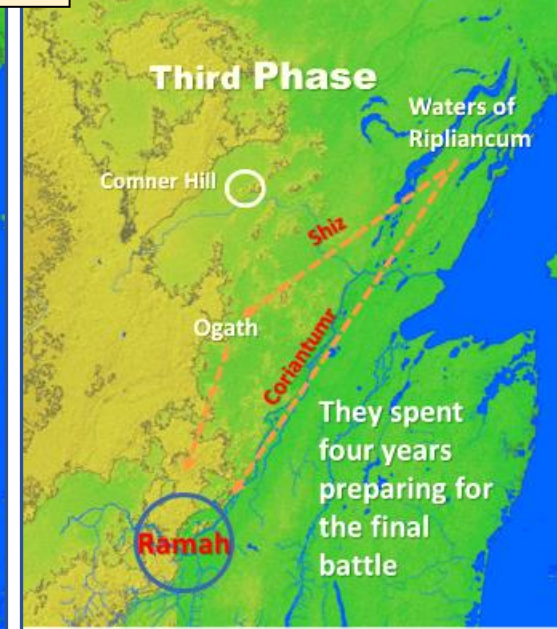
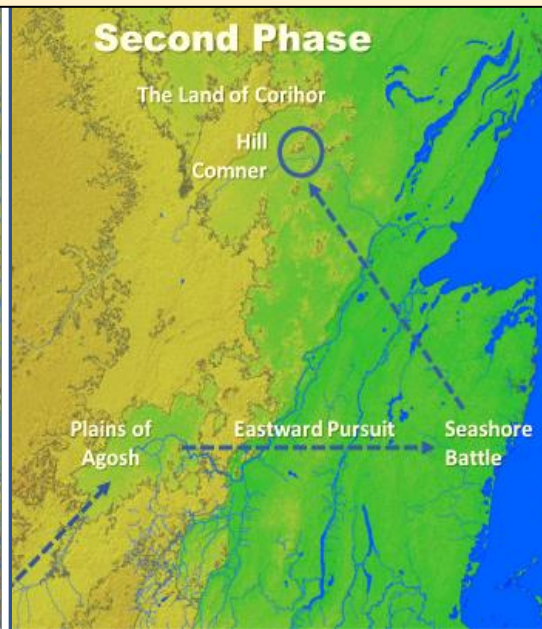


Final Jaredite War



Phase 1

Ether 14:11...Coriantumr came up (200 m higher) unto the land of Moron (from Akish) ...

Ether 14:13 And it came to pass that Coriantumr pursued him; and Lib gave battle unto him upon the seashore.

Ether 14:14 And it came to pass that Lib did smite the army of Coriantumr, that they fled again to the wilderness of Akish.

Ether 14:16 And when he (Coriantumr) had come to the plains of Agosh he gave battle unto Lib, and he smote upon him until he died

Ether 14:25 And it came to pass that Lib did pursue him until he came to the plains of Agosh.

Phase 2

Ether 14:26 And it came to pass that Shiz did pursue Coriantumr eastward, even to the borders by the seashore, and there he gave battle unto Shiz for the space of three days.

Ether 14:28 And they pitched their tents in the valley of Corihor; and Coriantumr pitched his tents in the valley of Shurr. Now the valley of Shurr was near the hill Comnor

Phase 3

Ether 15:8...he (Coriantumr) came to the waters of Ripliancum

Ether 15:10 And it came to pass that the armies of Coriantumr did press upon the armies of Shiz that they beat them, that they caused them to flee before them; and they did flee southward, and did pitch their tents in a place which was called Ogath.

Ether 15:11...army of Coriantumr did pitch their tents by the hill Ramah; and it was that same hill where my father Mormon did hide up the records unto the Lord, which were sacred.

Other Scriptures that are helpful in the positioning of Jaredite sites.

Alma 63:5...the land Desolation...by the narrow neck which led into the land northward

Ether 10:20 And they (Lib and Kish) built a great city (Uaxatun) by the narrow neck of land

Ether 7:6 Now the land of Moron...was near the land which is called Desolation by the Nephites.



Physical evidence that justifies the positioning of sites associated with the final Jaredite war:

- Early Formative sites in northern Belize match the Tower of Babel time frame. These sites tie to their destruction and to the “place of their first landing” Ether 22:30.
- The area around the hill is located in one of the most productive agricultural regions in Mesoamerica. This area could provide food for millions of Nephites or Jaredites. The Jaredites took four years to gather their people and prepare for war.
- The hill was located in an area where there are massive deposits of chert. Chert is ideal for building weapons of war. Chert and obsidian are difficult to find in other areas of Mesoamerica.
- The hill is along a major trade route. This would enable the gathering of their respective peoples. This trade route would also facilitate the escape route that the Nephites took when they left the land of Desolation.
- There are numerous caves in the area that would accommodate Ethers rock cavities.
- Hill Achotal is large enough to accommodate hundreds of thousands of warriors.
- There are (1) three rivers in close proximity to hill Achotal (2) there are over twenty cenotes within five miles of hill Achotal. They become fountains during high rainfall periods. (3) There are numerous lakes and wetlands in the area. These features accommodate the requirements found in Mormon 6:4 “it was in a land of many waters, rivers, and fountains”.
- Hill Comner is possibly the highest hill in the Yucatan and has two valleys on each side of it that are ideally situated for the valleys of Shurr and Corihor that are mentioned in the Ether 28. This hill also triangulates well with the waters of Ripliancum and eastern sea shore battle.
